To limit opportunities for COVID-19 Transmission

The Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council recognizes this tribal community is also seeing a surge in positive COVID-19 infections like surrounding areas are experiencing. The recent public health conditions caused by the COVID-19 virus, a communicable disease, require this Community to implement stricter protective measures until infection rates are better controlled. The Community is required to comply with the following measures to limit opportunities for infection.

The Tribal Council issues a ban of large gatherings. Gatherings should be limited to 40 persons or less. If open, public buildings, not including health care facilities and residential buildings, occupancy shall not exceed 75% of room or building capacity.

Visitors and customers who are fully vaccinated are not expected to wear a face mask in tribal buildings.
